Ryan is a 26-year-old Caucasian Male residing in a Host Home Companion Care home setting at his home located at 5706 Spanish Flat, San Antonio, TX 78222. Ryan resides with Anselmo, his wife and children, their family dog, and another individual in services. Ryan shares a bedroom with another client in service, LAR Steven has provided consent for them to reside in the same room. Ryan has a bedroom in which he is able to retrieve as needed and decorate to their liking. Ryan resides in a safe and supportive environment that helps to promote his health and well-being. Ryan's home is equipped with smoke alarms and has a lock on their bedroom door per HHSC requirements for program providers and Texas Council of Community Centers to comply with HCS Program rules at 26 TAC §263.502. Ryan is not able to dial 911 and communicate appropriately in the case of an emergency, and requires guidance and assistance when evacuating during an emergency. It was discussed and agreed that Ryan's roommate will assist with evacuation in the case of emergencies. SPT discussed that the SC must visit with the individual in person at least once every 90 days or more frequently as needed. Ryan selected to receive services in person, phone calls, and video visit for better flexibility. Ryan does not wish to move at this time as he is comfortable living with his HHCC family. Ryan wishes to continue to reside with his HHCC family and be able to practice grabbing what he wants. SC was informed that within the past year, Ryan has stopped voicing his wants or needs and instead has been pointing as main form of communication. Ryan wishes to continue to practice pointing or grabbing for the things that he wants or needs. Ryan will occasionally point to where his supplies are stored to indicate needing to be changed, or grabbing a bag of cookies or chips when he wants a snack, or a glass when he's feeling thirsty. It's important to Ryan to practice pointing or grabbing what he wants and needs to feel more independent. Backup plan: In the case that Anselmo is not able to provide HHCC services, his wife Ruth Martinez (210-887-3728) will become their backup plan. In the case that she is not able to provide HHCC services, LAR Steven

(512-632-6337) will become their backup plan. In the case that neither are able to provide HHCC services, Ryan's provider agency Lifetime Living will become responsible for finding Ryan a new HHCC provider or appropriate home setting that LAR Steven approves of.
